

Happy Easter!

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Trace Egg Shape onto Wrong Side of Fabric & Cut On Line

Supplies:

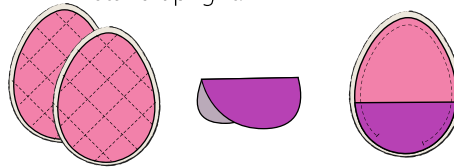
2 Fabric Pieces Cut Along Egg Line

2 Batting Pieces Cut $\frac{1}{2}$ " Larger than Fabric

2 Pocket Fabric Pieces Cut from Dashed Line to Bottom of Egg Template

Filling

1. Pair Egg & Batting pieces and quilt as desired. Trim batting to $\frac{1}{4}$ "- $\frac{1}{2}$ " larger than fabric.
2. Sew Pocket pieces together on straight side, Right Sides Together. Then turn right side out and press.
3. Sandwich Egg Pieces Wrong Sides Together, with Pocket on top aligned with fabric.
4. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " in from fabric edge to join, leaving a 2"-3" opening for stuffing.
5. Fill egg, and topstitch to close opening. Use pellets or other heavier stuffing to help egg stand upright!
