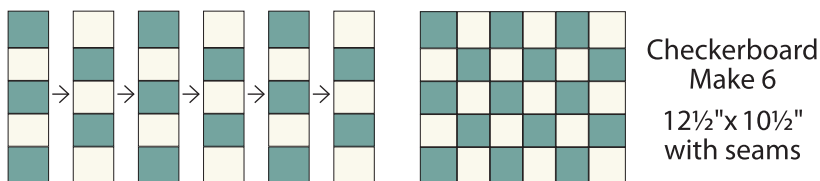
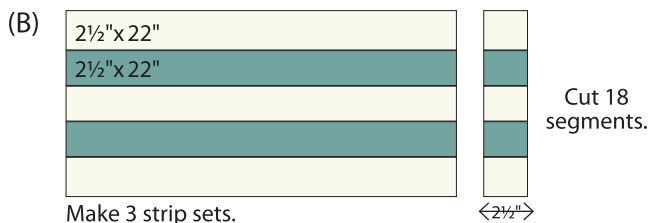
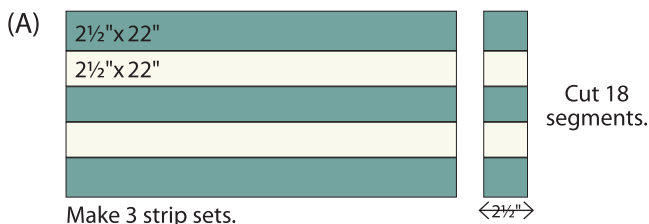
Quilter Basics

Read instructions before beginning a project.
All instructions include a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.
22" measurement is approximate.
WOF—approximately 40".

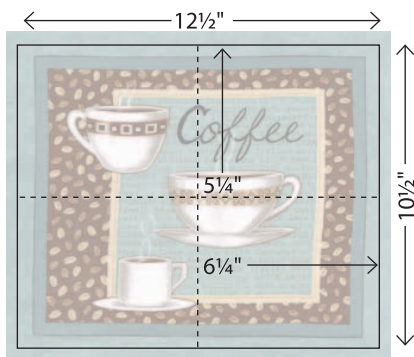
Quilt is 45"x39" Table runner is 21"x39"

Quilt & Table runner Construction

- 1 Checkerboard Block:** (A) Sew $3-2\frac{1}{2}" \times 22"$ Print and $2-2\frac{1}{2}" \times 22"$ Background strips together. *See diagram.* Press away from the Background strips. Make 3 strip sets. Cut into $18-2\frac{1}{2}"$ segments. (B) Sew $2-2\frac{1}{2}" \times 22"$ Print and $3-2\frac{1}{2}" \times 22"$ Background strips together. Press away from the Background strips. *See diagram.* Make 3 strip sets. Cut into $18-2\frac{1}{2}"$ segments. (C) Combine segments to make 6 Checkerboards.



- 2 Panel:** Measure $5\frac{1}{4}"$ from the center height and $6\frac{1}{4}"$ from the center width of the panel to cut a $10\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle. *See diagram.* Cut 6 Panels.

Quilt & Tablerunner Assembly

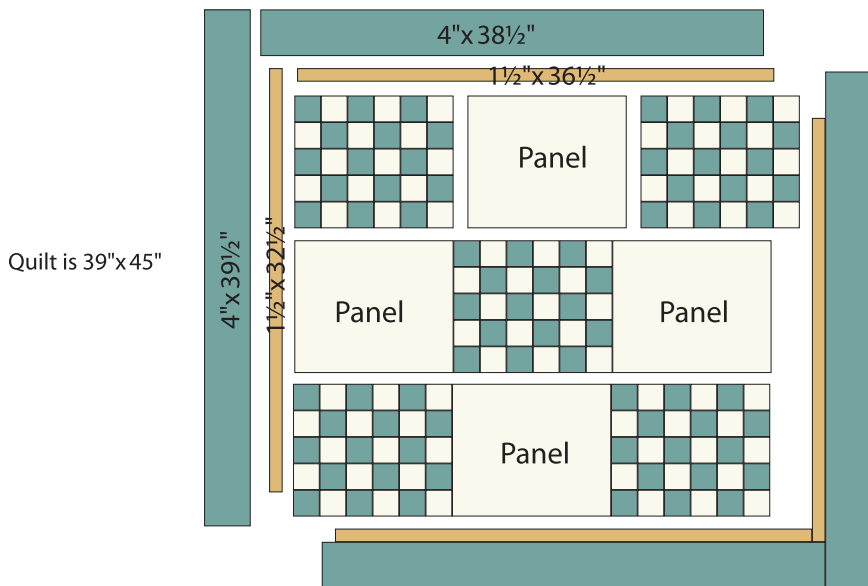
3 Join 4 Panels and 5 Checkboard Blocks into 3 rows of 3 blocks. *See diagram.*

Press towards the Panels. Join the rows. Add the borders in the following order:

- Inner borders: 2-1½"x36½" Top & bottom
- 2-1½"x32½" Sides

- Final borders: 2-4"x38½" Top & bottom
- 2-4"x39½" Sides

Layer, quilt and bind.



4 Join 2 Panels and one Checkboard Block. *See diagram.* Add the borders in the following order:

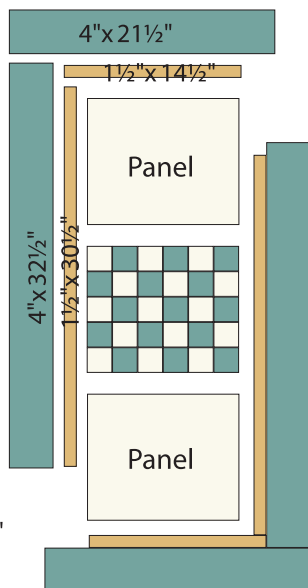
- Inner borders: 2-1½"x30½" Sides
- 2-1½"x14½" Top & bottom

- Final borders: 2-4"x32½" Sides
- 2-4"x21½" Top & bottom

Layer, quilt and bind.

Fabric Requirements for 2 Projects:

Checkerboard: 5 assorted prints
9"x22" of EACH

Background: ¾ yard

Inner Border: ¾ yard

Final Border: one yard

Binding: ¾ yard

Backing: Quilt - 1½ yards
Tablerunner - ⅞ yard

Cutting

Checkerboard:
from EACH of 5 Prints cut
3-2½"x22" strips

Background:
8-2½" x WOF strips
subcut 15-2½"x22" strips

Inner Border:
2-1½"x32½ strips (quilt)
2-1½"x36½ strips (quilt)
1-1½"x WOF strip
subcut 2-1½"x14½ strips
2-1½"x30½ strips

Final Border:
2-4"x39½ strips (quilt)
2-4"x38½ strips (quilt)
2-4"x21½ strips
2-4"x32½ strips

Binding:
8-2½"x WOF strips
